
FINDING YOUR WAY AROUND

Tarrant Valley Railway 009 Wimborne Railway Society

The Tarrant Valley Railway tells the story of the narrow gauge line that led from the Somerset and Dorset at Spetisbury up the Tarrant Valley past Tarrant Rushton aerodrome to the village of Tarrant Gunville. Very little evidence of the line remains to this day and some people question whether it ever existed.

Turners Wharf 00 Wimborne Railway Society

The Society's latest project depicting a commercial dockyard which will incorporate a dry dock, dockside working cranes and a grain conveyor for loading and unloading. Tablets and smart phones are used for operating the layout.

Francombe Fields Wimborne Railway Society

West Clayton N Ken Aveyard (Wimborne Railway Society)

West Clayton is a fictional station situated somewhere around the West Yorkshire and Lancashire boundary. Time frame is roughly 2000-2005 with passenger services in the hands of multiple units. The presence of a wagon repair shop allows for an assortment of freight and parcels trains. The layout is a work in progress with much more detailing to take place.

Crickton N Chris Aston (Wimborne Railway Society)

Crickton is an N scale tramway featuring a selection of scratch built and kit trams with a couple of scenic nods to the Tramway Museum at Crich.

The Rhatische Bahn Nm9 Paul Steedman (Wimborne Rly Soc)

A metre gauge line in the mountains of Eastern Switzerland. Modules interchange for various size and shape layouts. Look out for the Glacier Express.

Capulus Ridge Z Steve Cross

An ongoing project showing the terrain building method with running "out of the box" models from Marklin, Microtrains and AZL.

Kingsmouth 00 Gavin Brown and Alexander Atkins

A fictional BR mid 1950's Southern Region branch line terminus set towards the end of southern steam in June 1967. It's still a work in progress and all models are fitted with DCC sound to help bring the layout to life.
